Location

The Cahernane House Hotel is an exceptionally well located hotel in a stunning picturesque setting only 2 km from Killarney town centre. With a tree lined avenue the hotel is situated on its own private grounds which extend to 2.65 ha (6.5 acres) and overlooks Killarney National Park and lakes. The hotel is on the popular Muckross Road and walking distance from the town.

Activities nearby include golfing, horse riding, cycling, fishing, lake boating or take a jaunting car ride to appreciate the scenery of Killarney National Park. Tennis and croquet are also available.

Killarney is Ireland's premier tourist town and a popular destination for national and international visitors attracted to the region for its natural beauty and vibrant town centre. The Ring of Kerry is synonymous with the region attracting huge numbers of visitors annually to the area to experience the coastal, mountain and lake scenery of the famed Iveragh and Dingle Peninsula's. Killarney is strategically positioned as a base to explore these unique attractions including the popular Wild Atlantic Way experience.



History

Formerly the Residence of the Herbert Family the Earls of Pembroke, Cahernane House Hotel Killarney Ireland dates back to the 17th Century.

Two Brothers, members of the Pembroke family, whose ancestors had fought on the Yorkist side during the War of the Roses, came to Killarney in 1656.

One Brother was given the Muckross Estate and the other the property of Currens and Cahernane. The Herbert family maintained these Estates for five generations.

By 1872 the rent roll was declining as a result of pressure by the Land League under the presidency of Charles Stewart Parnell.

Henry Herbert, like most other Irish Landlords, was determined to maintain appearances and to do so kept carriages, horses, boats, boatmen, gardeners and gamekeepers.

In 1877 he replaced the old family mansion, one of the few remaining Queen - Anne buildings in Ireland and in its place he built Cahernane House Hotel.



Cahernane House Hotel is an exclusive hotel providing guests with the best of old world character and modern hotel luxury in a scenic setting.

With a tree lined avenue entrance from Muckross Road the hotel includes 38 luxurious bedrooms located in the original house and a more recent addition linked with glazed double height conservatory. The hotel has the elegant Herbert Room Restaurant, located in the main house, which caters for 80 patrons. The Drawing Room and Library reception rooms with feature open fireplaces are situated off Reception. At basement level, the Cellar Bar provides a warm atmosphere for residents and locals.

Adjacent to the hotel is a two storey stone façade former Managers House which would suit conversion to self catering use (subject to planning).

The Bedrooms

Hotel bedrooms include deluxe standard rooms and superior rooms as well as the Herbert and Muckross Suites. The classic antique rooms in the original house are beautifully restored and individually decorated to capture the atmosphere of a Victorian time.

The deluxe rooms are located through the conservatory providing the extra luxury of private access to the garden.

The superior garden rooms are decorated and styled in keeping with country manor traditions.

The Herbert Suite is situated at the heart of Cahernane House. The traditional bedroom and sitting room afford a unique taste of the splendour of a genuine manor house. Beautifully restored and decorated to capture the atmosphere of an earlier era, the elegantly large windows offer inspiring views of the gardens and mountains of the National Park.

The Muckross Suite is tucked away in the quietest corner of the hotel, with a large private balcony and decorated in country house style overlooking the National Park.

The Herbert Room Restaurant epitomizes the style and grandeur of a 17th century country house. The award winning restaurant is located in one of the old dining rooms off the main reception area.

Cosy and inviting the Cellar Bar also offers a delightful bistro style menu served in the afternoon and evening.











Weddings


The Cahernane Hotel's various reception rooms and restaurant can cater for groups of up to 85 people and by using an additional room can seat 110 guests.
